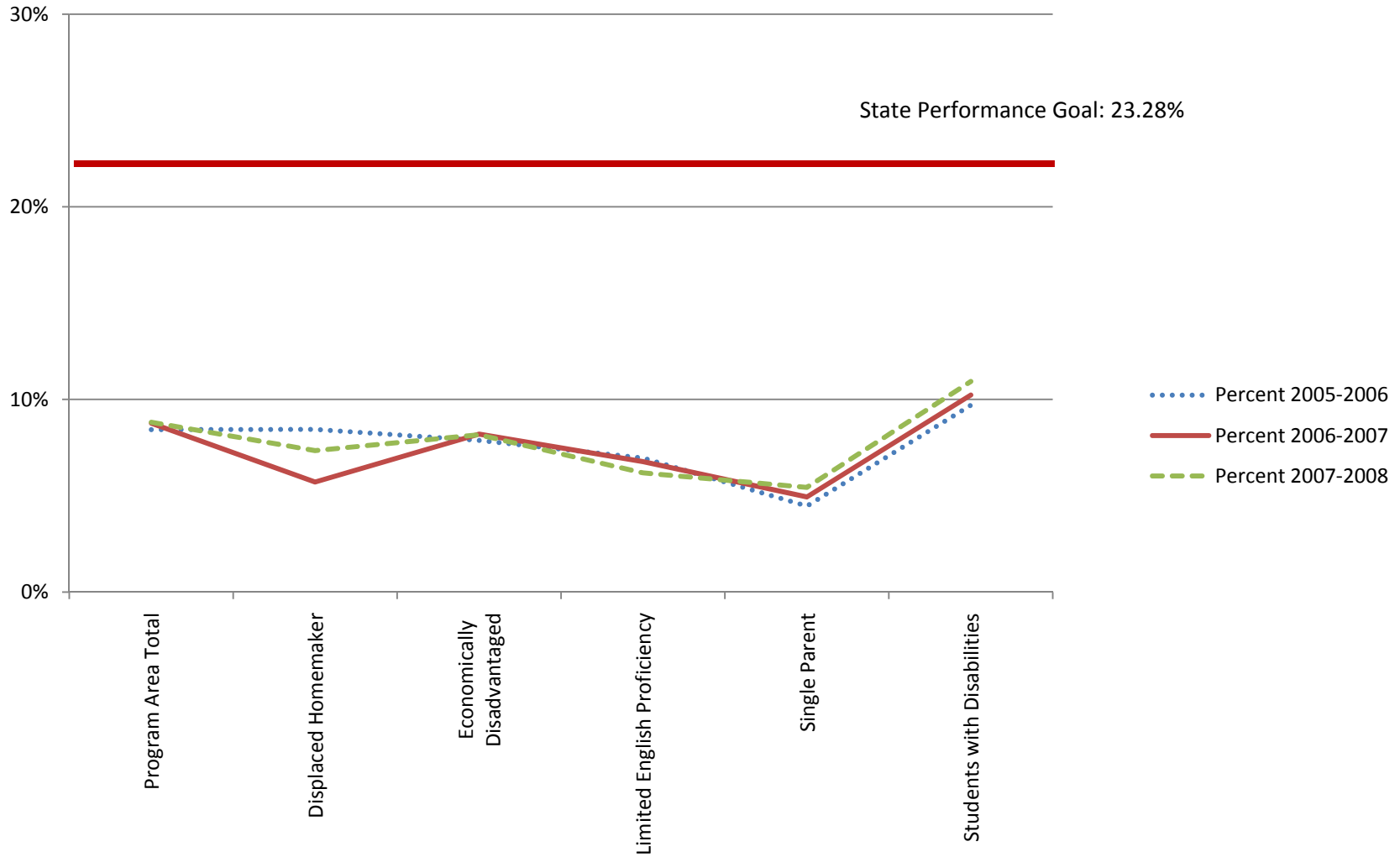


**Perkins IV Core Indicator 5P2: TOP Code 13 – Family & Consumer Sciences – All Colleges**
